

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR FREE DIGITAL STORYTELLING TEACHER TRAINING TRIP

PLEASE FIND THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO WIN A FREE PEACE WORKS TRAVEL DIGITAL STORYTELLING TEACHERS TRAINING TRIP 2017 BELOW:

OFFICIAL FREE TRIP SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **HOW TO ENTER:** No Purchase Necessary. To enter, contestants should apply for a scholarship at www.peaceworkstravel.com. Required information includes the contestant's name, address, telephone number, school information, teaching credentials, resume and cover letter. One entry per person.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** The scholarship opportunity is open to either full or part-time teachers at the middle school, junior high school or senior high school level living in the United States. Employees (and their immediate families and household members) of Peace Works Travel and its affiliates are not eligible.
3. **GRAND PRIZE:** The scholarship (a total of 5 scholarships will be awarded) will include a trip for one teacher (at least 21 years of age) to Guatemala, July 7-15, 2017. The scholarship excludes airfare and personal expenses as further detailed below. The scholarship will be allocated to qualified teachers at the discretion of the Peace Works Travel team that is also leading the tour. The scholarship cannot be applied to anything other than this trip.
4. **SELECTION OF WINNERS:** The winner will be selected and notified by Peace Works Travel by May 1 2017. Participants are assessed on specific criteria indicting their potential for maximum professional development benefit and furthering global competencies of their students. Participants agree to be bound by these rules and decisions, that are final. All eligible entries will remain in possession of Peace Works Travel. Peace Works Travel will notify the winner by phone, email or standard mail. Peace Works Travel, its affiliates agents and others working for them or on their behalf, will have the right to photograph the winners and entry constitutes permission to use their names, pictures, likenesses, school's name and city and state of residence(s) in advertising for no additional compensation.
5. Starting dates and ending dates for receiving applications are February 21, 2017, and April 20, 2017, respectively.
6. The odds of winning will depend on the qualifications of eligible applications received.
7. **DECLARING THE WINNER:** Scholarship must be claimed by May 8, 2017. Failure to execute and return any requested document(s) within 7 days of receipt, or return of notification or scholarship as undeliverable may result in forfeiture of free trip and an alternate potential winner being selected at the sole discretion of Peace Works Travel. Winners and all travelers must execute the Peace Works Travel forms & conditions.
8. Peace Works Travel makes no warranties with respect to the scholarship.

9. The free scholarship opportunity is void where prohibited or restricted by law and is subject to all Federal, State, and Local laws and regulations. All taxes on prizes are solely the responsibility of the winners. To learn the name of the winner, contact Peace Works Travel after May 1, 2017. Peace Works Travel is not responsible for any lost or misdirected applications. Scholarships are non-transferable and may not be redeemed for a cash equivalent. The free scholarship opportunity is eligible to residents of the United States only.

GENERAL

Once an applicant has been accepted, they will receive additional pre-course information, including health forms, equipment lists, air travel instructions and further information about the program.

Our intention is to create a course that addresses the goals and program elements as listed in each program description. Participants are advised to note that course itineraries can change. When changes are made to incorporate participant goals and interests, adjust to the health of the group, or made necessary because of foul weather, problems with transportation, political unrest or any other unforeseen problem, we will work to structure the course so that it stays true to its original intent.

TEACHER TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP EXCLUDES:

Not included are personal expenses such as the cost of obtaining passports, visa fees, laundry, medical fees, cost of evacuation, airport taxes, e-mail, health and travel insurance, extra baggage fees, phone calls, etc. The cost of international air fare is not included in the teacher training trip price.

AIR TRAVEL

Participants are responsible for booking their own travel to and from the start and end points of our teacher training trip.

MEDICAL AND EVACUATION EXPENSES

It is the responsibility of the participant to understand the limits of any medical and evacuation policy, and to provide up-front payment of emergency services when required.

PEACE WORKS TRAVEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

If a participant acts in a way that is injurious to himself or herself, people of the host country, other participants on the trip, or generally conducts himself or herself in a way that is disruptive to the program, we reserve the right to terminate our relationship with the participant. Irresponsible use of alcohol and the use of illegal drugs are cause for dismissal. Participants who leave the program for any

reason, including sickness, personal emergencies or injury, will be responsible for all medical costs, and will absorb travel and related costs associated with an unscheduled departure.

CANCELED TRIP

Peace Works Travel reserves the right to cancel any trip though due to any event that is beyond our control. Peace Works Travel is not responsible for other costs incurred by clients preparing for the trip.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Applicant must be in possession of a valid passport for international travel, complete with usable visa pages. The date of expiry must be beyond 6 months from the date of course departure. Detailed instructions for acquiring appropriate visas will be sent to the winners of the free trip scholarships.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS AND SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

All Peace Works Travel programs are designed to engage with local communities and access regions of exceptional natural splendor; they therefore all require participants to be in good physical health. If you have any questions regarding the physical demands of a program, please call. All participants will be responsible for submitting to us a completed health form that completely and accurately represents the current mental and physical well-being of the participant. Peace Works Travel guides have the right to disqualify any member from the group if considered medically necessary, and will do so if a participant falsely represents him/herself on the participant's health form or any other required paperwork. In the event of a medical emergency, Peace Works Travel will attempt to procure medical treatment; however, we assume no liability regarding provision of medical care. Participants are urged to check their insurance coverage for its adequacy when outside of their own country, or to purchase travel health insurance.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

Participants will be required to read and sign an "Assumption of Risk Agreement" prior to participating in our program.
